Joy of Giving Day is on Wednesday, April 26, 2023, from midnight to 11:59 PM Central time. The platform opens for donations during an Advanced Giving Phase beginning at Midnight Central time on Monday, April 10th.

What will MOQ be doing for Joy of Giving?

We want our school to participate along with other Archdiocese schools and parishes to promote awareness and community involvement for the Catholic community throughout the Archdiocese of Omaha.

Along with the foundation of our Catholic Faith and academics, we believe that a healthy body and mind are essential for a successful future. Joy of Giving funds raised this year will support our Specials programs (Art, Library, Music, PE, Spanish, and STEM) and Tuition Assistance Program.

Our goal is to raise \$10,000 (about \$20/student). To celebrate our participation in Joy of Giving, the students will be rewarded with a Color Run on April 26th, at 2:30 PM. The MOQ Color Run will be a short campus walk/run and students will have the opportunity to be doused with different colors of powder. More information will be shared in the upcoming weeks.
